CSX Chair in Management and Accounting - This chair was established in 1983 by The CSX Corporation, which has long recognized the role of a strong educational system in the growth and quality of life in our country.

Clarence E. Denoon, Jr. Professorship of Science - Established in 1993 by Clarence E. Denoon, Jr., alumnus and former Board of Trustees member, this professorship recognizes scientists who are also excellent, inspiring teachers.

Floyd D. and Elisabeth S. Gottwald Chair in Chemistry – In 1993 the Gottwalds augmented their family’s support of the sciences at Richmond, which included a 1978 gift from the Ethyl Corporation to name the science center, by establishing a fund that has grown to support two separate chairs. Floyd D. Gottwald, Sr. and his son, Floyd D. Gottwald, Jr. a University alumnus, both served on the Board of Trustees.

Tyler Haynes Interdisciplinary Professorship – This endowed position was established to honor Dr. W. Tyler Haynes, one of the University’s most committed and generous graduates and trustees. The holder typically has an appointment in more than one school and/or department.

F. Carlyle Tiller Chair in Business – In 1983 Wheat First Securities made a grant to establish this endowed position to honor its President and CEO, Richmond alumnus F. Carlyle Tiller, who served the University as a member of the Board of Trustees and Rector, and as a lecturer in the Robins School of Business.

Tucker-Boatwright Professorship in the Humanities – Established by graduate and Trustee Dr. James T. Tucker to honor Dr. Frederic W. Boatwright, former President of the University of Richmond, two positions (one in philosophy and another in art) recognize professors “of outstanding ability and magnitude.”

Carole M. Weinstein Chair of International Education – Established by alumna and former Trustee Carole M. Weinstein, a long-time generous supporter of international education at Richmond, this chair recognizes a faculty member or administrator who is pivotal to the advancement of international education at the University of Richmond.

Patricia A. & George W. Wellde, Jr. Distinguished Chair in Finance – This chair was established in 2001 by the Welldes to attract nationally recognized faculty in the field of finance to the Business School. Mr. Wellde, a Richmond graduate and retired Vice Chairman of Goldman, Sachs & Co., currently serves as Rector of the Board of Trustees.
